1. Notice of AGM

The AGM will be held at 12h00 on Monday 20th August at the Institute of Natural Resources, Scottsville, Pietermaritzburg. The agenda, minutes from the last AGM and various portfolio reports will be sent out in due course.

2. Subscriptions and membership

Hendrik has posted the 2007 accounts. Subscriptions for 2007 have been set at R244 for RSA members which includes R219 (R192 + VAT) for Nisc and R25 for the Society. Rest of Africa and Overseas members do not pay VAT and will pay a total of R217 (R192 + R25). An invoice will be posted for 2007 subs and a statement will be included for those that are in arrears (i.e. still owing for 2006 and before).
