Dear SASAQS Delegates

Our 2016 congress will be hosted by North West University's Research Unit for Environmental Sciences and Management in the Kruger National Park from 26-30 June 2016.

A panel of international acclaimed researchers will act as keynote speakers with our theme: Aquatic Research, Management and Conservation in a rapid changing world!

CALL FOR PAPERS

Abstracts in all fields of aquatic (freshwater, estuarine and marine) sciences are invited. The deadline for submission of abstracts and posters is the 12th of February 2016. We will not do electronic posters and the size of the poster boards is A0 in portrait (84.1 cm wide x 118.9 cm tall lamination included.)

Please submit electronically on <http://savetcon.conference-services.net/directory.asp> It will require you to register with Oxford Abstracts, just follow the procedure.

- Abstracts can be submitted for consideration either as oral or poster presentations.
- Oral presentations: 15 minutes, that include a few minutes for questions.
- Please ensure that e-mail addresses as submitted are correct, as these addresses will be used in all correspondence and acceptance notifications.
- Maximum length: 250 words
- Late submissions will not be considered

Delegates will be informed of the outcome via oxford abstracts by the 20th of February 2016.
